

Prof. Vijaya Kumar, University of Paradeniya, Sri Lanka

Title: Laboratory to Commercialization – Challenges for Developing Countries

Professor Vijaya Kumar obtained his D.Phil in steroid chemistry from the University of Oxford and served at the University of Peradeniya, Sri Lanka for over 40 years having been Senior Professor of Chemistry and Dean of Faculty. He was Chairman of the Industrial Technology Institute of Sri Lanka from 2004 to 2013. His research interests have been in Insect Chemical Ecology, Biopesticides, Biological Chemistry, Natural Products Chemistry, Herbal Medicine and Science Policy. He has about 70 publications in international journals. He is the immediate Past President of the National Academy of Sciences of Sri Lanka and of the Science Council of Asia. He has been the Chairman of the UN Commission on Science & Technology for Development in which he was the Sri Lankan representative for 12 years. He was also a member of the UN Millennium Development Project Task Force 10 on Science, Technology and Innovation from 2003 to 2005. He has received many Presidential Awards for Research and in 2005 was awarded the National Honour of Vidya Nidhi.
