Prof. Chulbom Lee, Seoul National University, South Korea

Professor Chulbom Lee went to Seoul National University to receive B.S. (1988) and M.S. (1990) in Chemistry under the direction of Professor Eun Lee. After brief stay in the Korean Army in 1992, he proceeded to Stanford University to work with Prof. Barry Trost for his Ph.D. studies. In 1998, he moved to Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center to work with Prof. Samuel Danishefsky as US Army Breast Cancer Research Postdoctoral Fellow. Upon completing his postdoctoral studies in 2001, he joined the faculty of the Chemistry Department of Princeton University as Assistant Professor. In 2008, he moved back to his alma mater, SNU, and has remained there as Professor of Chemistry. He has served as Associate Chair of the Chemistry Department (2013-15), SNU Faculty Senator (2015-16), Vice President of the Korean Chemical Society (2014) and the Korean Society of Organic Synthesis (2012), and Review Board Member of the National Research Foundation of Korea (2015-16). He is currently Associate Editor of Organic Chemistry Frontiers (RSC) and on the advisory board of Chemical Reviews (ACS), while serving as Chair of the KCS International Committee, EXCO member of FACS (Federation of Asian Chemical Societies) and national representative of IUPAC Div. VII committee.
